

**24/10/05 TT No.86: *Dave Reed* - Cambridge University Press (Kershaw Cambs League Premier Division)**

Along with friend Ken Kenealy, I attended the Cliff Bullen Cambridge Challenge Cup game on Saturday between Cambridge University Press of the Cambridgeshire League and Wimblington Old Boys of the Peterborough League.

After a decent lunchtime touring some of the Cambridge pubs we returned to the ground which is located withing the University Press complex. The roped off pitch is pleasantly situated and runs lengthways away from the modern pavilion which has changing rooms underneath a bar which which was selling alcoholic drinks, with teas and coffees from a machine. No other refreshments appeared to be available. A decent sixteen-page programme inside a glossy cover was available, apparently free as they were left in an envelope on the bar.
