Cottenham United play in the small village of Cottenham which is to the north of Cambridge. Pass through Histon and you have about another mile to travel. The ground is situated off Lambs Lane; look for the signs saying Recreation Ground.

The ground is very basic. A roped off pitch with a large club house on the side. Entry to the game is free and a club official walks around the ground selling the match programme for £1.00. The programme is excellent with lots of information about the club and is very well presented; it also doubles up as a ticket for the half-time raffle.

The match was played to quite a good standard. Cottenham dominated the first half but five minutes before half time Littleport scored with their first chance of the game.

A refreshment point serves teas, coffee's etc and also sells club lapel badges for a very reasonable £2.00.

The second half was well contested with Littleport running out 2-1 winners.

A very enjoyable evening and a pleasant visit to a well-run club.
