

TT No.86: *Barry Neighbour* - Saturday 2nd December 2006; **London APSA 1 Eton Manor 6**; Essex Senior League; 3*; Programme: 7 x A4 pages printed on both sides and stapled together - £1.

London APSA play at The Terence McMillan Stadium alongside Newham Leisure Centre. It is a typical Sports Centre complex with a running track between the pitch and the stand which means that you are a little far away from the action. The ground is on Prince Regent Lane and is easily reached from Prince Regent Docklands Station which has several buses passing the ground or it is a 15-minute walk.

The game was over as a contest within 12 minutes by which time Eton Manor were 2-0 up. The first came in the 3rd minute when a strong run into the APSA area was not stopped and the forward tucked the ball away. The second came after a break down the right saw the ball played back and a low shot in the corner gave the keeper no chance. On the stroke of half-time Eton Manor scored a 3rd after a bout of pressure saw a shot go through a forest of legs leaving the keeper rooted to his line. On the hour the ball was knocked back past the 'keeper to make it 0-4. The fifth came in the 80th minute following a break down the left and a shot that curled past the keeper. Two minutes later Eton Manor scored their 6th when a through ball saw the forward lift the ball over the keeper and run it into the empty net. APSA scored a consolation with 6 minutes to go when the forward ran onto a through ball into the area making a final score-line of 1-6.
