

TT No.111: *Ian Harkness* - 21st March 2008 - Jornada 30; **CF Gava** v Orihuela CF; Spain Segunda B; Result: 1-0; Attendance: approx. 300; Prog: A4 Team sheet, Free; FGIF Match Rating: 2*.

F Gava play at the Estadio Municipal, La Bobila, in Gava. The ground has a capacity of 2500 and there is an Athletic's track around the pitch. It has a main stand with a social bar/shop on the far left. There are three to four rows of seating along the side of the pitch. The ground also has floodlights.

Although it was a nice dry hot day, there was very little football played until near the end when Gava scored in about the 90th minute, which pleased the home fans a lot. This result kept Gava at the top end of the table. The crowd was not very noisy but then again this was normal I would say for lower league football!

The attendance was approximately 300 although local papers and magazines seemed to double the figures!! The cost was 10 euros to get in with a nice coloured match ticket. The programme issued was a free A4- sheet on entry. This contains past match reports, a league table and bits and bobs. If you arrive too early the team line ups might not be included (after a short wait these are handed out later). It doesn't seem that many programmes are printed.

It is easy to get to Gava by local train from Sants station. Take the train going towards Sitges/St Vincents and get off at Gava which is only about 15 minutes from Barcelona. It is best to go into the town centre and follow signs for the ground, a walk of approximately 25 minutes.
