

**TT No.228: Gyles Basey-Fisher** - Tues 20th April; KO 6.30pm; **Loughborough FC** v Genesis FC; North Leicestershire League Premier Division; Result: 1- 2; Admission & Prog: £1.00 (16 pages); Attendance: 23.

The move to their new ground could be between 5 and 10 years away according to one of only two club officials I witness, he ran the line, the other, the tea bar. The move to a new ground is on the condition that industrial units are built on the current ground, but the recession has set the project back years, there is now talk of getting lights at the ex-Midland Combination venue.

They produced a 16-page programme for this midweek fixture. When I arrived about 70 minutes before kick-off there were only 4 left on the counter of the well-stocked tea bar; at half time I counted 3! One interesting note was that the cover photo was taken by a hopper on a recent visit.

If visiting the ground, follow Derby Road out from the town centre, eventually, at a roundabout, you will see a sign for 'Derby Road Playing Fields' off to the right. This will take you through an industrial estate - keep following signs and finally you reach a clearing, keep following the road, which turns into a track, you can see the ground in front of you through some trees, you will need to take the right fork and the track will lead up to the ground. The Postcode on Loughborough FC's website takes you to the town centre!
