Stourport on Severn is a picturesque town, still with old world charm. The football ground lies on one side of the river, cross the bridge, and you have the option to walk along the river, take a boat cruise, or stroll around the town centre.

Back at the ground, the entrance is behind one goal, with the changing room and clubhouse nestled by the corner flag. There is a veranda outside the clubhouse, offering a small amount of covered standing accommodation. The only other covered spectator accommodation is a seated stand which straddles the half way line.

The game was unspectacular, with both goals coming in the second half, the first direct from a free kick. Stourport looked as though they wouldn't score if they played until midnight, and it could be a long season for them. Reasonable programme, giving all the information required.
